Post: Tutor in the Department of Guitar Studies.
Tutor in the Department of Drums Studies.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for appointment to the full-time or part-time post in the Department of Guitar and Drums Studies, commencing September 2011. The appointments for full-time tutors would be for three years in the first instance.

Qualifications:

A Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University in Music Education with all types of Guitar and drums instruments for full-time tutors and a lower level education for part-time tutors. The ability to teach both classical and pop/jazz and Caribbean music styles would be an asset. Relevant teaching experience for at least 3 years is required.

Duties:

These would include:

- (1) Teaching guitar (classical, folk, electric and electric bass) or drums to part-time students of all ages from beginners to advanced levels, with some practical examination work for the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM), UK.
- (2) Developing ensemble work within the Guitar and Drums Department.
- (3) Preparing students for and assisting with the organising of student concerts.
- (4) Performing as soloist/accompanist in staff recitals and student concerts.
- (5) Assisting with at least one of the school's main ensembles: Community Choir, Community Orchestra, School ensemble or Jazz Ensemble.
- (6) Contributing in other areas of the applicant's special interest and the department's needs.

Salary:

Based upon applicant's qualifications and experience.

Video submission:

Short listed applicants from outside St Lucia will be required to submit a video of their teaching and playing.
