- (1) Teaching General musicianship to part-time students of all ages from Grade I to advanced level, with some practical examination work for the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM), UK.
- (2) Preparing students to read and write music with accuracy.
- (3) Preparing students are equipped with all the necessary skills for reading and writing music of all styles.
- (4) Ensuring students reach the required levels for ABRSM Examinations.
- (5) Contributing in other areas of the applicant's special interest and the department's needs.
